



Step One: Log In to the UPK Colorado portal

Go to upk.colorado.gov/dashboard. If you see your name on the screen, you are already logged in. If you are not logged in, you will be prompted to log in.

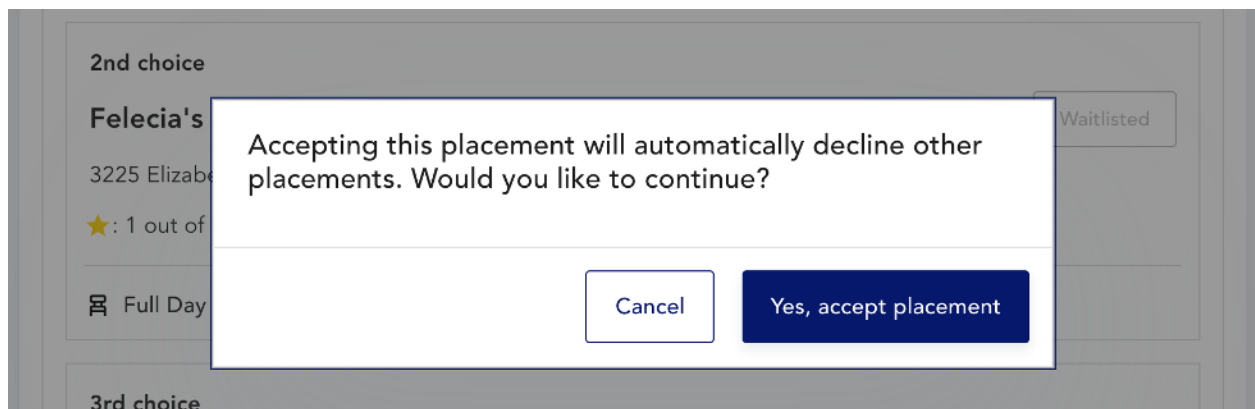

Step Four: Accept or Decline Match Offer

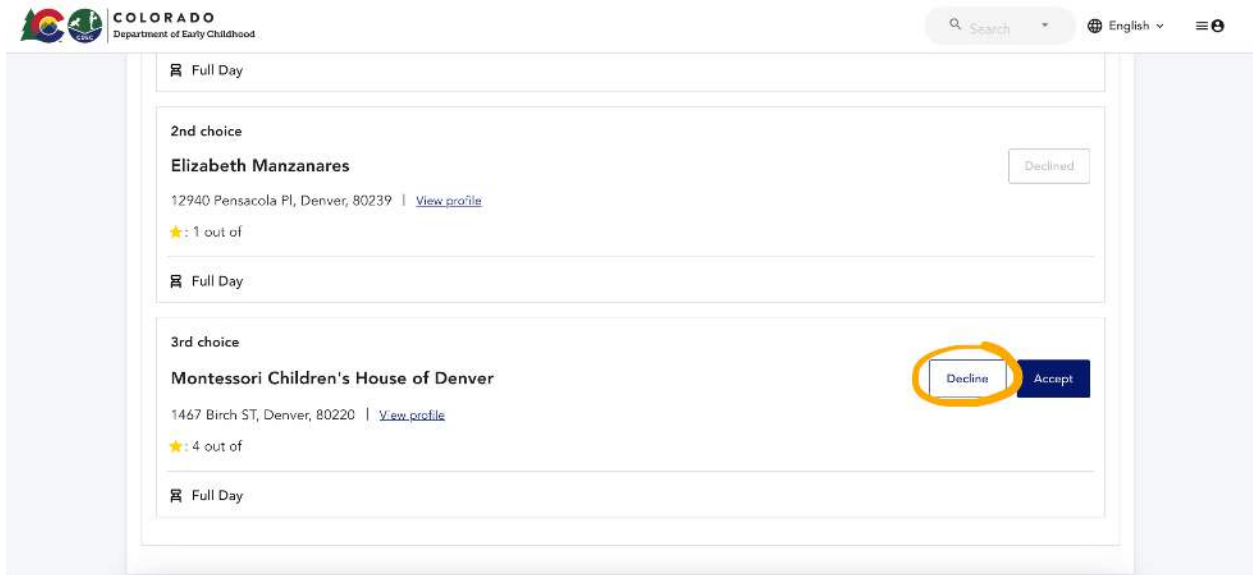
If you are happy with your match and want to continue with the program, click Accept.



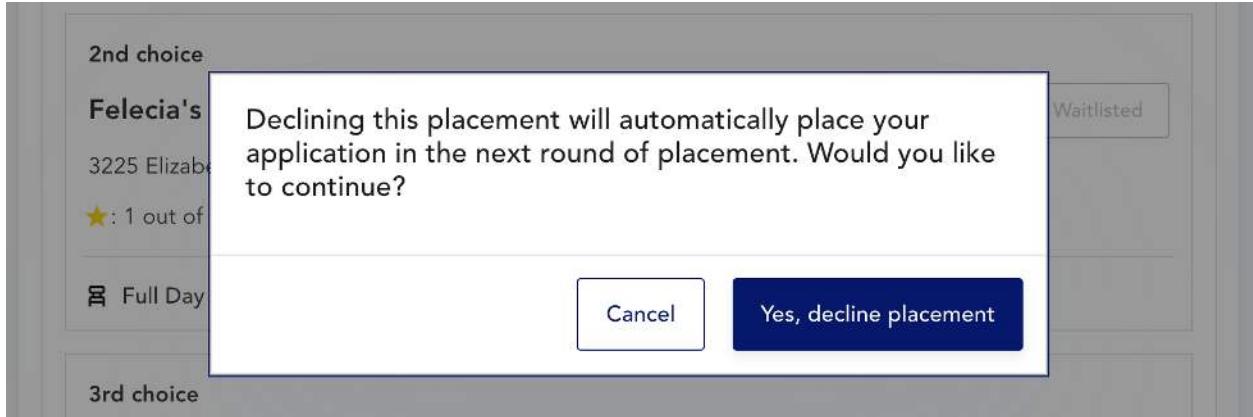
You will see a pop-up confirming that you intend to enroll at the program. Once you have completed this, the status of the match will change to Accepted. You do not need to take any additional action.
