

# FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS IN JEFFERSON COUNTY



## Nurse-Family Partnership

Nurse support for first time parents/caregivers throughout pregnancy until child turns two.



## Alma Project for Maternal Mental Health

Community support for families with children up to 3 years old and during the prenatal period.



## Cuenta Conmigo Cooperative

Supports Spanish-speaking families with breastfeeding, child nutrition, and infant mental health.



## Child First

Works with parents and children to build a strong, loving, parent-child relationship that protects and heals the brain from trauma and stress.



## Colorado Community Health Alliance

Coordinates care and services for Colorado Medicaid members, including medical and non-medical services.



## Family Connects Colorado

Nurse visits (1-3) for any family with a newborn baby.



## Early Intervention through DDRC

Supports families of children from birth to their third birthday who have developmental delays or disabilities.

Helps parents/caregivers prepare children from birth to age 5 for success in school and beyond.

Monthly visits for families with children through kindergarten age and during the prenatal period.

Home safety, child health, parent/caregiver child interaction education for families with children 0-5 years.



## NayaCare Postpartum Home Visiting

Medical newborn care, newborn feeding, maternal wellness; accepts Medicaid
