

FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAMS IN JEFFERSON COUNTY



Nurse-Family Partnership

Nurse support for first time parents/caregivers throughout pregnancy until child turns two.



Alma Project for Maternal Mental Health

Community support for families with children up to 3 years old and during the prenatal period.



Cuenta Conmigo Cooperative

Supports Spanish-speaking families with breastfeeding, child nutrition, and infant mental health.



City of Lakewood Head Start

Supports families in their role as caregivers and teachers of their children 0-3 years and during the prenatal period.



Colorado Community Health Alliance

Coordinates care and services for Colorado Medicaid members, including medical and non-medical services.



Family Connects Colorado

Nurse visits (1-3) for any family with a newborn baby.



Early Intervention through DDRC

Supports families of children from birth to their third birthday who have developmental delays or disabilities.



HIPPY Program

Helps parents/caregivers prepare children 2-4 years for success in school and beyond.



Early Childhood Family Services

Family therapy, parenting resources, school-based services, psychological assessments, and more.



Parents as Teachers

Monthly visits for families with children through kindergarten age and during the prenatal period.



Jefferson County Human Services

Specialists connect families to services, work to strengthen connections between families and the community and more.



SafeCare

Home safety, child health, parent/caregiver child interaction education for families with children 0-5 years.



Recovery Nurse Advocate Program

Prenatal and postpartum support for people with a history of or current substance use disorder.



NayaCare Postpartum Home Visiting

Medical newborn care, newborn feeding, maternal wellness; accepts Medicaid
